ELIGIBILITY - Active duty personnel, retired military, reserve component members, ROTC cadets, civilian DoD employees, NAF employees, CAP members, government contractors, and others who support the DoD mission and their family members are all eligible.

CLUB FEES - \$30 initiation fee (lifetime - transferable to any other military Aero Club)
\$25 monthly dues (are automatically charged to your Visa or MasterCard)

BILLING - Aircraft rental, instructional fees, and supplies are charged to your credit card (Visa or MasterCard) or can be paid for by check. Payment must be made the same day services are rendered.

SAFETY MEETINGS - Are mandatory and are held on the third Thursday of each month at 5:00 p.m. at the Oasis Community Center.

SCHEDULING – Internet based, www.flightschedulepro.com. 24/7 access.

CROSS COUNTRY & TDY - Club aircraft may be used for Cross-Country trips and qualify for use on TDY.

LEARNING TO FLY - The Aero Club teaches Private Pilot through Air Transport Pilot all of which are FAA part 141 certified courses. VA benefits apply on all licenses and ratings above Private Pilot. The minimum part 141 requirements to obtain a Private Pilot license are 20 hours dual instruction and 15 hours solo. A **3rd Class Student Pilot Medical** is needed before your 1st flight as well as copy of your Birth Certificate or Passport and a Government ID. **Flight Training Kit** – Internet Based Instruction. Cost \$329.00. Active duty members may be able to use tuition assistance which pays up to 65% .
